

TEDU NON-THESIS MASTER'S PROGRAM

Admission to non-thesis master's program

Is the student going to have a scientific preparation program?

YES

A Scientific preparation program may be offered for compensation to the students who have received their graduate/undergraduate degrees in a different field than the graduate program they were admitted to as well as those who have received their graduate/undergraduate degrees from another higher education institution. [ARTICLE 17/1](#)

The [scientific preparation form](#) is filled by the GSPAD.

In order to successfully complete the scientific preparation program, student must receive minimum grade of CC for each course and the GPA must be at least 2.50/4.00. Courses and credits taken during the scientific preparation program are not counted among those taken for the graduate program, or the grades received during the scientific preparation program are not included in the GPA for the graduate program. [ARTICLE 17/3](#)

Maximum period of study for the scientific preparation program is two semesters. Student can take courses in the Summer School; however, it is not considered as a separate semester. This period cannot be extended except for suspension and the student is dismissed from the program in case of failure at the end of the given period. [ARTICLE 17/5](#)

Are the courses completed with at least a grade of CC?

The student repeats the scientific preparation

YES

The student goes through the course selection process.

An academic staff member holding a doctoral degree is assigned and reported by the GSPAD as an advisor to assist the student in the course selection and term project.

In the graduate program without thesis, the GSPAD appoints a faculty member or a lecturer with a doctoral degree who will advise each student in the course selection and carrying out of the term project until the end of the first semester the latest. The appointment of the advisor is finalized with the decision of the GS Executive Board. [ARTICLE 21/1](#)

The student must enroll in the term project course during the semester in which the term project course is taken.

The subject of the term project is submitted to the GSPAD by the student and the advisor until the end of second semester.

Does the program directorate approve of the term project subject?

YES

Finalization of the term project subject by the decision of the Graduate School Executive Board.

The student who has completed their term project is obligated to submit their written report by the end of the semester.

Electronic and hard copies of the term project report are submitted to the GSPAD.

The student modifies their term project.

Electronic and hard copies of the term project report are submitted to the graduate school by the GSPAD.

The student presents their term project.

Students who successfully complete their credit courses in the graduate program without thesis with a grade of at least CC and a GPA of 3.00 / 4.00 and the term project in a maximum of three semesters are awarded a graduate degree without thesis. [ARTICLE 22/1](#)
